

How to Become a Data Specialist

Come and join the Data Specialist team, and find out how the results are figured out!

Data Specialists progress through four levels – Introductory, Level I, Level II and Level III.

The Introductory level is meant to provide an introduction to the principles of data assessment (no exam). To be designated as an Introductory Data Specialist you must:

- a) Be at least 16 years of age by the time of appointment.
- b) Attend an introductory training session as set out by the Section Data Specialist Committee.
- c) Successfully assist at a minimum of two competitions.
- d) Be recommended by the Section Data Specialist Committee to continue training to become a Level I data specialist.
